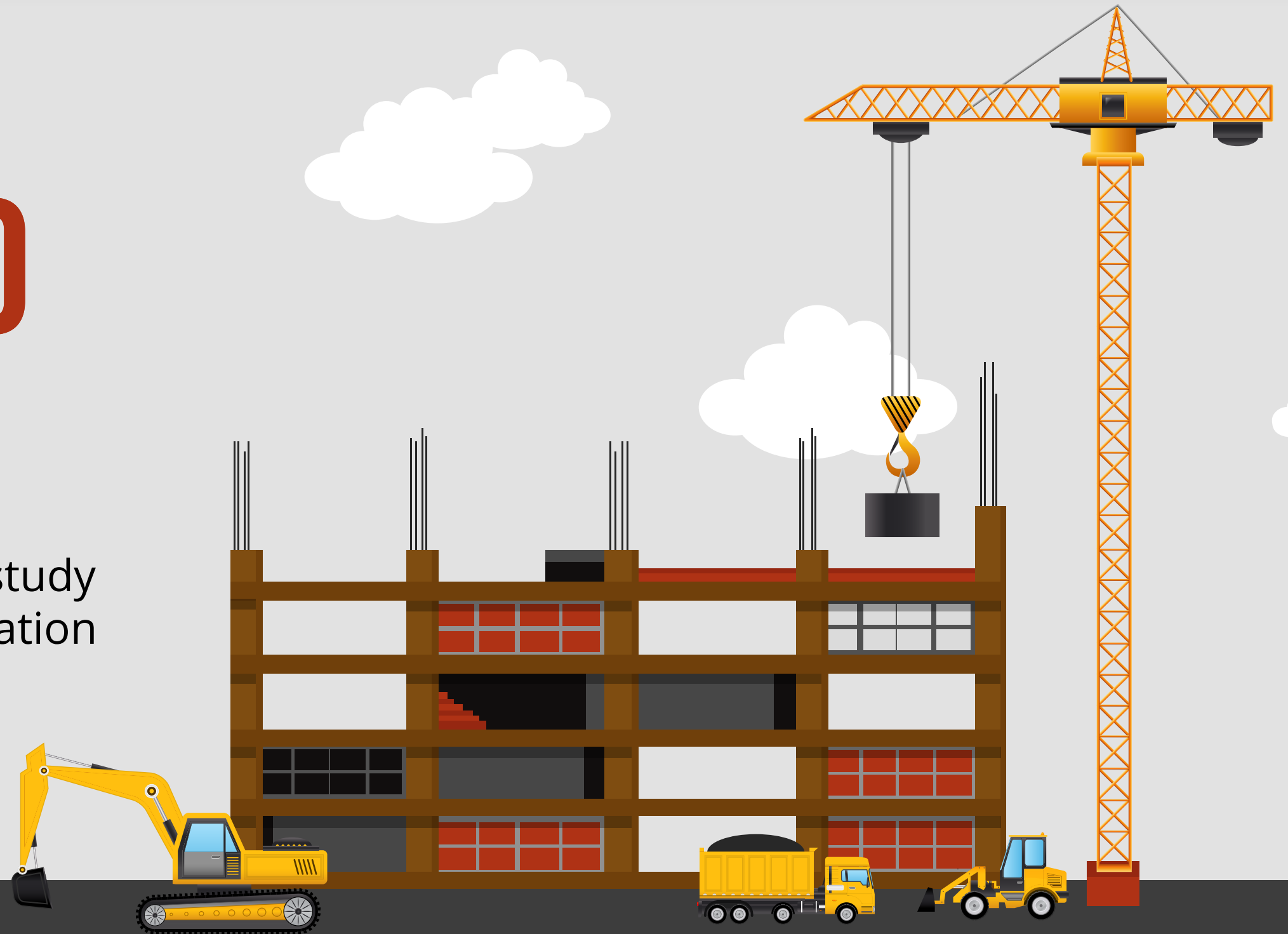

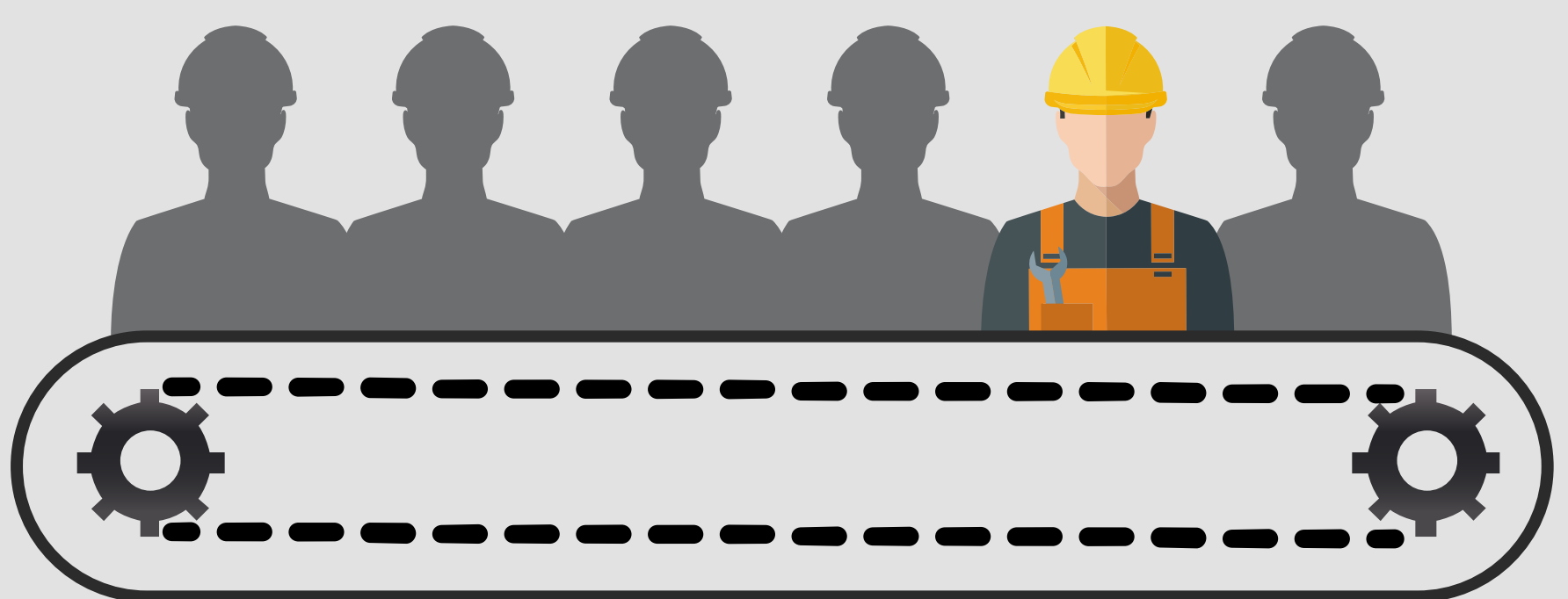

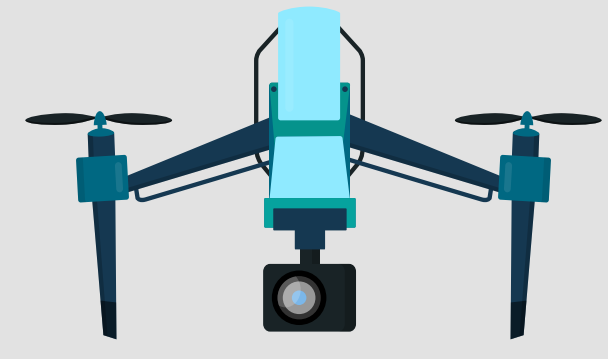

operators out of harms way.



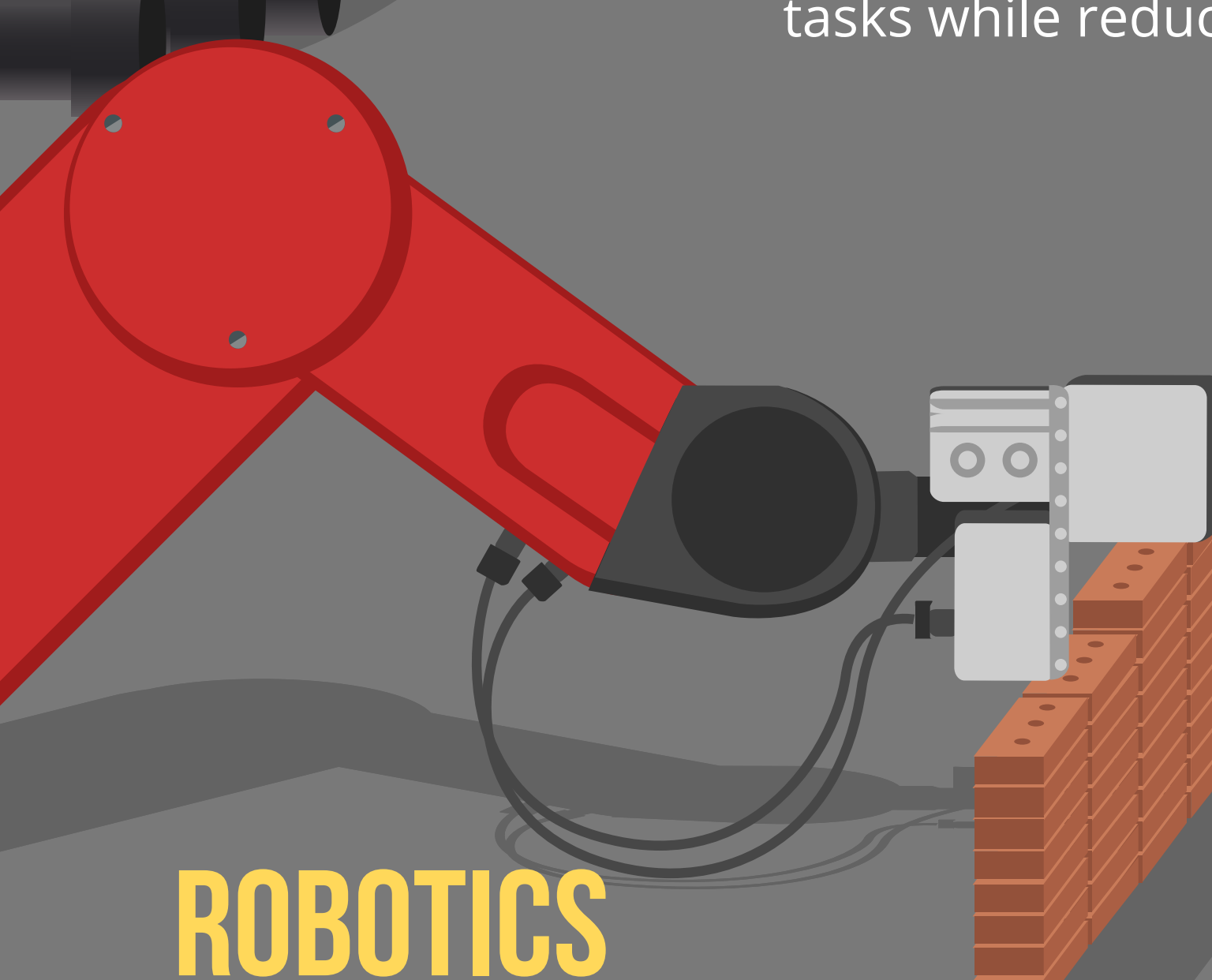
EXOSKELETONS
